Sustainable Management," was attended by over 150 participants, with 101 oral presentations and 18 poster presentations. The full papers were published in three volumes: 1 - Regional Hydrogeology, 2 - Hydrochemistry, Quality, and Pollution, and 3 - Hydrogeology of Salt Flats and others. https://congresohidrogeologia.unlpam.edu.ar/evento

The Congress featured keynote lectures delivered by John Cherry, Ricardo Hirata, Miguel Rangel, Ingrid Vargas, Carla Moscardi, and Corina Rodríguez.

In addition to the XII Argentine Hydrogeology Congress, three pre-congress courses were held on September 15 and 16, attended by a total of 50 students: "Water Chemistry and Quality" (taught by Dr. Carlos Schulz and Dr. Eduardo Mariño), "Environmental Hydrogeology" (taught by Dr. Miguel Auge), and "Groundwater Exploration" (taught by Dr. Esteban Tálamo).

A special tribute was given to Dr. Emilio Custodio, in recognition of his contributions to human resource development, the study, and understanding of groundwater in Argentina.

Coinciding with the Congress, the Assembly of the Argentine Chapter of the IAH took place, during which the group's leadership for the 2024-2026 period was elected.

#### 5. YOUR CHAPTER'S PLANS

The main activity of the IAH Argentina Chapter during 2025 is to consolidate the Revista Argentina de Hidrogeología (RAHi). This is a periodical publication that aims to cover a gap in terms of the need for articles on hydrogeology in Spanish. It is promoted by the Argentine Chapter, with the collaboration of researchers from universities and science and technology institutes from all over Latin America.

The articles refer to scientific research and technical papers on hydrogeology, with a special focus on the different regions of Argentina. From theoretical and methodological studies to applied research, the RAHi promotes the advancement of hydrogeological knowledge through open



access, free distribution and a commitment to the 'ad honorem' work of its team.

In addition, seminars and conferences in association with various national and international organisations are planned for 2025. The organisation of the Hydrogeology Congress 2026, which is planned to be held in the city of Mar del Plata, is currently in progress.
